

# Fifth Sunday of Easter ~ April 27 and 28, 2024

In today's gospel passage, Jesus promises His disciples that His relationship with them will remain even after His death. His words, like the vine, will remain with them. As we encounter Jesus through the Word of God, worshiping community and the Eucharist, we too can bear fruit in His love and continue His work of reconciliation in the world. This bond between Jesus and His disciples is the foundation for their strength to continue to do the mission that He began. It is very important, then, that when He says to us "I am the vine and you are the branches," what it means is that we, as Christians, do not just apparently walk with Him or experience Him but rather He is within us, in each other, in our community, and in those outside our community. Because through His own incarnation He has become incarnate in every human being. We pray therefore that He remains always in us and we in Him so that we can walk the way Jesus walked, to care the way He cared and to love the way He loved. ~ Fr. Caroli Shao, A.J.

### Traditions and Treasures

Today we hear Jesus say that He is the true vine and we are the branches. The comparison of the chosen people with a vine was used in the Old Testament: Psalm 80 speaks of the uprooting of the vine in Egypt and its replanting in another land; and in Isaiah's Song of the Vineyard (Isaiah 5:1-7) God complains that despite the care and love he has lavished on it, His vineyard has yielded only wild grapes. Here, the comparison has a different, more personal meaning: Christ explains that He Himself is the true vine, because the old vine, the original chosen people, has been succeeded by the new vine, the Church, whose head is Christ. To be fruitful one must be joined to the new, true vine, Christ: it is no longer a matter of simply belonging to a community but of living the life of Christ, the life of grace, which the nourishment that passes life on to the believer and enables him to yield fruits of eternal life. — Rev Bernard J. ### Pro-Lífe Corner

#### The meaning of choosing to receive the Holy Eucharist:

The Church has taught consistently for 2000 years that those who receive the Eucharist are publicly professing their Catholic faith and are seriously striving to live by the moral teachings of the Church. Those who reject the teaching of the Church on the sanctity of human life and those who do not seek to live in accordance with that teaching place themselves in contradiction to the communion of the Church, and so should not receive the sacrament of that communion, the Holy Eucharist. We all fall short in various ways, but there is a great difference between struggling to live according to the teachings of the Church and rejecting those teachings.




### Knights of Columbus Bonanza Raffle

Mary accompanying her Son on this journey to Indianapolis is a reaffirmation of this," said David Carollo, Executive Director, WAF/Blue Army.

In a letter of support, Tim Glemkowski, Executive Director of the Eucharistic Revival Congress, said the pilgrim virgin statue processions will "visibly demonstrate Our Blessed Mother's accompaniment of this Eucharistic Revival journey the Church is undertaking collectively. The Eucharistic Revival, in my view, is distinctly Marian in its heart, part of the work of the Sacred and Immaculate Hearts to heal, convert, form and unify the Church so that it can be sent on mission 'for the life of the world.' Our Blessed Mother never obscures her Son, but invites all to behold and know Him fully."


